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Faculty Achievements



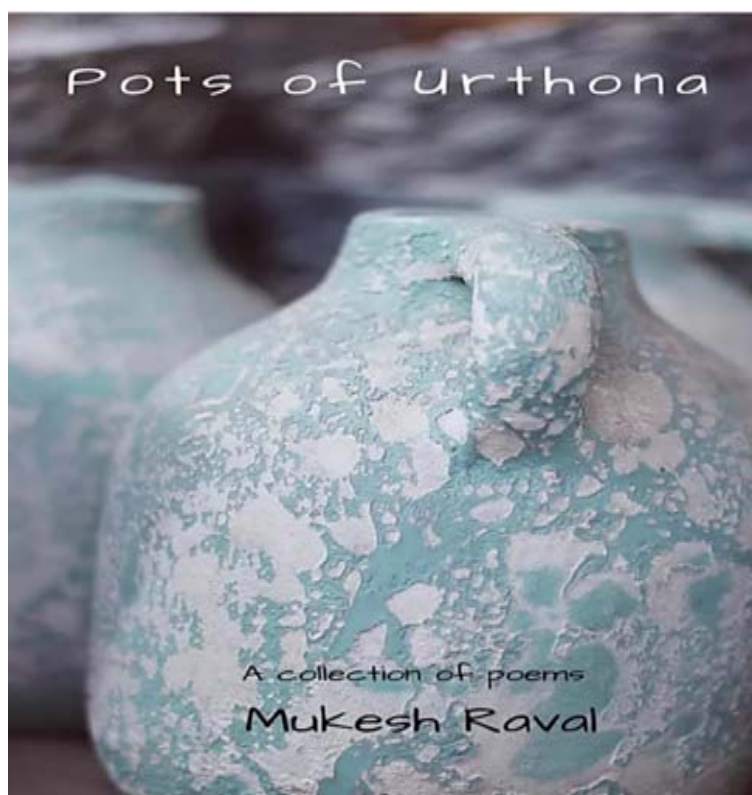

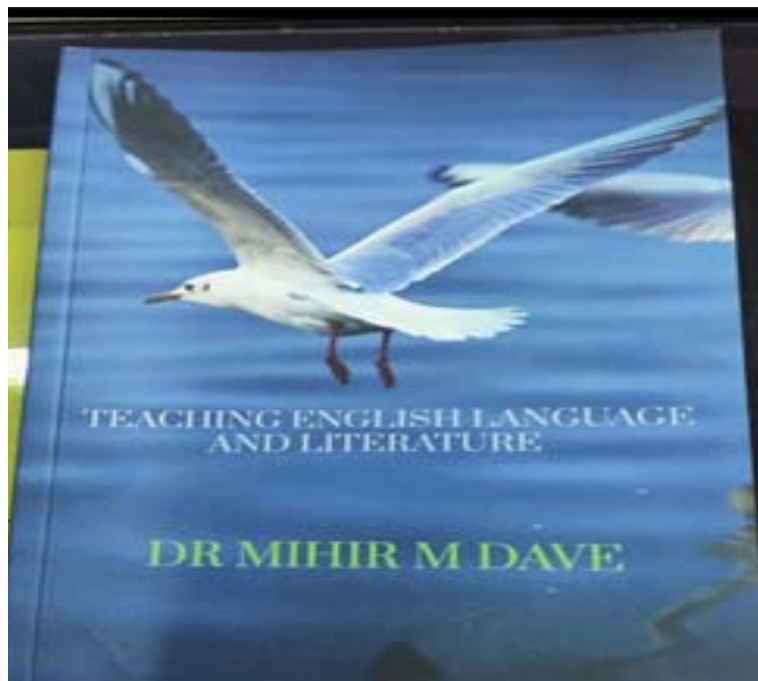


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Dr Mihir Dave, another Senior Faculty of English published a book named **"Teaching English Language and Literature,"** which is available in our Library.

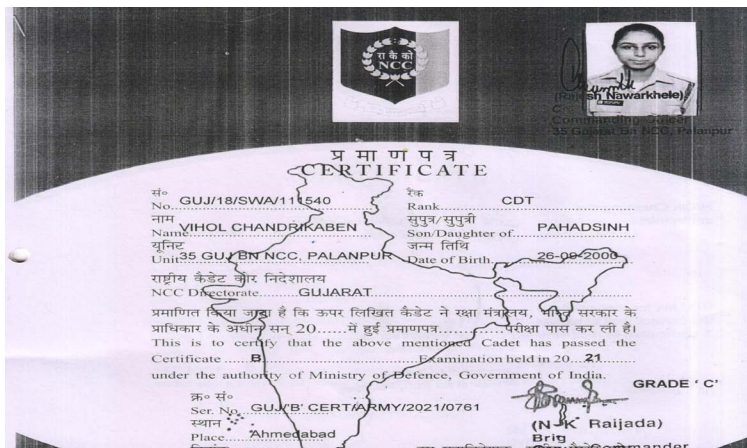

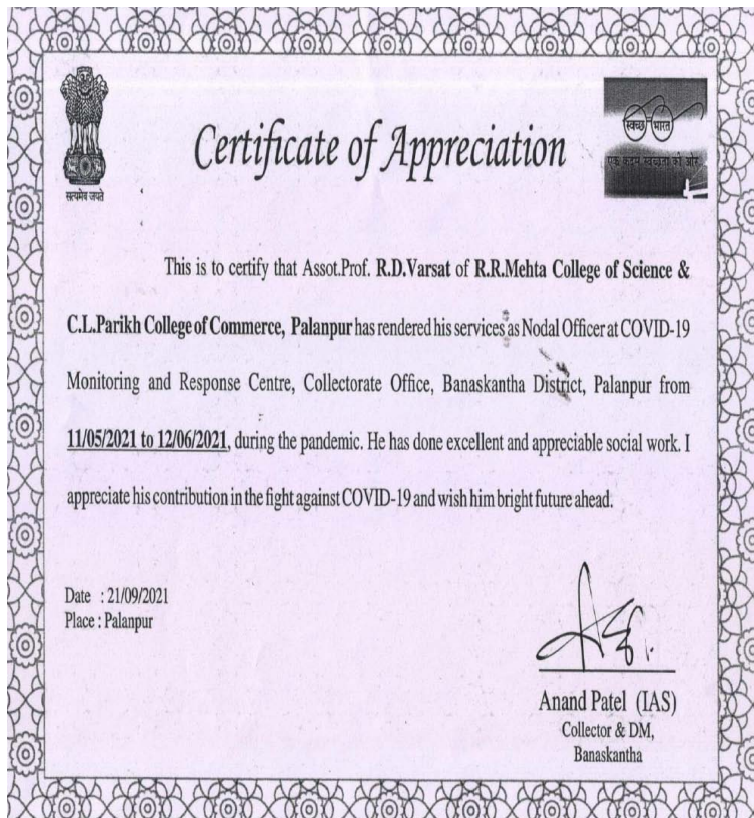

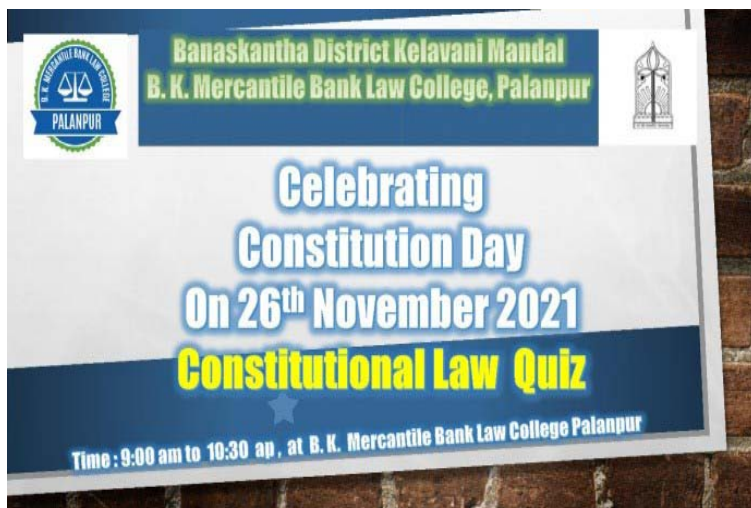
