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From the Editor's Desk

Inequalities are not new; there are rigid social controls and networks everywhere, and the barriers are difficult to break where caste-based reservations further complicate the equilibrium in our society.

However, the students who come to study here, are by and large less fortunate and more ignorant, and it adds to our responsibility to train them according the market scenarios. Are we ready to shoulder the additional responsibility? Merely to say that they are un-trainable and our institutions don't have resources to cater them, perhaps would be understating.

I felt personal grooming of the students is the key; exposing them to real-life situations are equally important, and offering them continues trainings is also critical. This can be done with the help of technological interventions. Therefore, we can reap the fruit if we practice it with sincerity and honesty.



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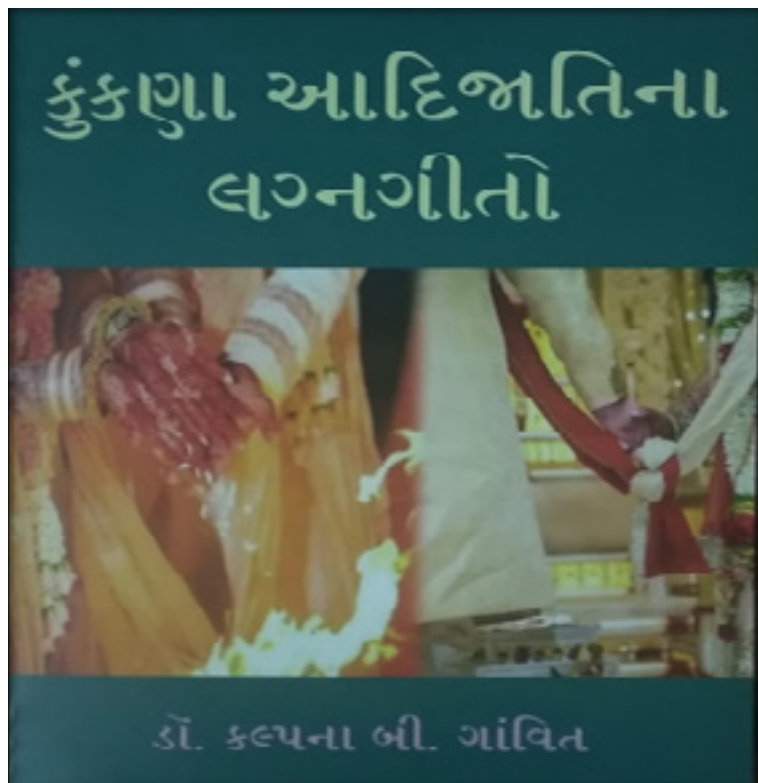
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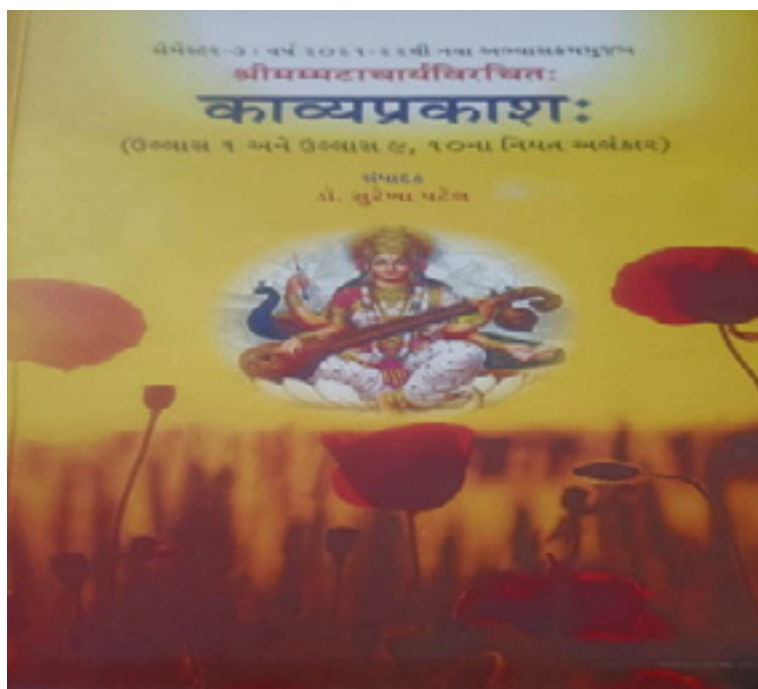
